



LIGHT AND SHADOW



Where the source of light is reduced or too far away.

Lighting from the side will not allow us to find all the highlights in the shadows. Some highlights will always remain hidden. This is why it is important to have two light sources. One light source will highlight the main features while the other will catch the shadows. This will give the figure more depth and dimensionality. Light and shadow are the most important elements in painting.

The bottom hatching shows the source below the figure above and almost on the floor. For many years I have used this hatching effect. The reasons are only make necessary realistic, but intensity can change and strengthen a subject. This method is an excellent and practical way to push a figure at any angle. Upon you now to work on the figures and observe the effect of the shadows.
