According to the Office of the Surveyor of the said Land amount to one CENTRAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL. the same having
having been originally by the said Henry B. Griffin to Major Brown in whose favor the said
trust, is here located.

"Now know ye, That there is a patent granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Major Brown as assignee as
aforesaid and to his heirs
the land of said above described To him and to hold the same in trust with the appurtenances thereto unto the said Major Brown as

heirs and assigns forever.
