Inkscape comes with a number of different predefined fill patterns. However, they are limited to black or white for colors. This tutorial will show how to change the color of the pattern.

1. Fill the shape/object of choice with the desired pattern with black for the color.

2. With the shape/object selected, select 'Replace color...' from the Extensions menu (Extensions > Color > Replace color)

3. The 'Replace color' box hex code should be 000000 (six zeros).

4. In the 'By color' box, use the hex code for the desired color change based on the chart below.

5. Click the [Apply] button. Then click the [Close] button after changes are applied.
